Required Registration Documents

The following forms of documentation may demonstrate a student's eligibility for enrollment in the district*.

1. **Proof of Birth**, any one of the items listed below;

- Original Birth Certificate
- Passport

2. **Residency Documentation**, any one of the items listed in category A and any one of the items in category B;

Category A

- Waldwick Borough Property Tax Bill for my residence
- Deed or Lease for my residence
- A notarized affidavit from the owner of my residence and myself stating that I reside at that residence on a full time basis. The Affidavit may be found on the website.
- Contract of Sale for my residence (for those just moving to Waldwick) and a copy of the Deed once conveyed.

Category B

- PSE&G Bill dated within the last 2 months
- Drivers License
- Mortgage Statement dated within the last 2 months
- Water Bill dated within the last 3 months
- Home or Apartment Insurance Certificate
- Bank Statement dated within the past 2 months

3. **Updated Immunization Record** from your child's doctor including month, day, and year of all required immunizations.

4. **Documentation of a Physical and Eye Examination*** dated after September 1, 2023 (Eye exam is for students entering Kindergarten only).

5. **The Open Registration Form** that you printed from your computer through the online portal.

6. **Release of Records Form-** For students coming from another school grades 1-5.
