













# COVID, FLU, COLD, & ALLERGY SYMPTOMS

SYMPTOMS	COVID-19	FLU	COLD	ALLERGY
<b>Sudden Symptoms</b>	Symptoms may worsen and become more severe.	The flu has a rapid onset within 3-6 hours.	Cold symptoms tend to develop over a few days.	Sometimes - when exposed to an allergy trigger.
 <b>Fever</b>	Common can last up to 2 weeks	Usually present 80% of all flu cases	Rare	Never
 <b>Coughing</b>	Dry persistent, severe cough associated with shortness of breath	Non-Productive non-mucus producing	Productive mucus producing	Sometimes
 <b>Aches</b>	Aches and severe fatigue	Severe aches	Slight body aches	Never
 <b>Stuffy Nose</b>	Rare	Not commonly present	Common	Common
 <b>Chills</b>	Common	Sometimes 60% of people who have flu	Uncommon	Uncommon
 <b>Tiredness</b>	Very Common	Moderate to Severe	Fairly Mild	Sometimes
 <b>Sneezing</b>	Unlikely	Uncommon	Common	Common
 <b>Headache</b>	Common may vary in severity	Very Common	Uncommon	Common
 <b>Sore Throat</b>	Sometimes	Uncommon	Common	Rare
 <b>Chest Discomfort</b>	Common can be severe and require hospital care	Often Severe	Mild to Moderate	Common may vary in severity

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
